- Assisting with acquiring and building costumes.
- Assisting with light hanging, focusing, and programming.
- Running the lightboard and/or sound board for our various theater shows.
- Serving as run crew for our various theater shows.
- Maintaining a clean and tidy backstage area.
- Maintaining an accurate inventory of costumes, props, and set pieces.
- Providing event support.
- Classroom, lobby, and theater set-up and clean-up.
- Depending on the interest and experience of the applicant, this internship may provide the opportunity to assist stage managers for our productions.
- Depending on the schedule of the applicant, this internship may provide classroom support for our Technical Theater after-school classes and summer camps.
- Other duties as assigned.
